-  Participants must complete and return entry form to the Jacksonville Recreation & Parks Department (JRPD) by Sat, December 3. There is no entry fee. Entry forms are available online at www.jacksonvillewinterfest.com or contact the JRPD at 910 938-5312.
-  The Jacksonville Recreation and Parks Department reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate or does not follow the rules or procedures.
-  All entries must be clearly labeled with participate name and category (Elementary, Middle, High School) and submitted on a thick and sturdy cardboard, wooden or plastic base no larger than 18"x18"x18".
-  Entrants agree that their name, photograph, and photo of entry may be used for publicity or advertisement without compensation to the entrant.
-  Except for the base, all entries must be 100% edible: made of gingerbread, pre-baked gingerbread or graham crackers. They can be decorated with candy or other edible embellishments. All icings and toppings must be edible, no caulking, spraying, or preserving can be used other than confections. No artificial display materials such as Styrofoam, interior lighting, or landscaping are to be used in construction. All candies/material must be unwrapped and free of any inedible materials.

-  Entries will be judged on: overall appearance, originality & creativity, architecture, construction and holiday theme. Judging will be held on Sunday, December 4 from 12-3PM during the public viewing at the Jacksonville Commons Recreation Center. The award ceremony will follow at 3:30 PM.
-  Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category.
-  Entries must be delivered to the Jacksonville Commons Recreation Center on Saturday, December 3 between 10AM-12PM or Sunday, December 4 between 10AM and 12PM. All entries must be picked up by 5PM on December 4. Entries not picked up will be discarded or displayed by the Jacksonville Recreation and Parks Department.
-  The City of Jacksonville and sponsoring agencies are not responsible for theft, damage, acts of nature, or destruction of entries.
